**2012 Guest Lecturer:** Coach Pete Gillen



Coach Gillen is currently a national college basketball analyst for CBS Sports following an illustrious career as the head coach at Xavier, Providence and most recently University of Virginia compiling an overall record of 392-221.

In each of his stops as a head coach, Gillen lead his team to the NCAA tournament advancing to the Elite 8 with Providence in 1997. Also, his teams made sixteen postseason appearances including nine times in the NCAA tournament.

Coach Gillen was inducted into the Nike Basketball Hall of Fame in 1997, the New York City Basketball Hall of Fame in 2008 and as well as the 5-Star Basketball Hall of Fame, a distinction he shares with Coach Buonaguro.

**Siena Head Coach:** Mitch Buonaguro



Mitch Buonaguro was named Siena's 15th head men's basketball coach on April 8, 2010.

Widely regarded as one of the most experienced and respected coaches in the country, Buonaguro has helped reenergize the Siena program in his seven years (five as the lead assistant) with the program, helping the Saints to three consecutive MAAC Championships and NCAA Tournament berths from 2008-2010. This past season the Coach Buonaguro lead the Saints to the best field goal percentage defense in the MAAC despite a shortened bench.

Buonaguro has amassed over 35 years and 1,000 games of Division I coaching experience as both a head and assistant coach.
